## CERTIFIES

I. That FADE has organized the World Congress of the Assemblies of God 2020, which was expected to take place in Madrid city in the Caja Mágica venue between the 19<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> of March 2020.

II. That, due to the advance of the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) both in the Spanish territory and internationally, on March 6<sup>th</sup> 2020, this organization is sent by the Ministry of Health of Spain, an official statement signed by the General Director of Public Health, Quality and Innovation, Mrs. Pilar Aparicio Azcárraga, whereby it is strongly recommended the postponement or suspension of the event.

III. That, under the above circumstances, for reasons of force majeure, in solidarity with society, defending the general social interest and in favor of public health, in addition to ensuring the health integrity of the participants, FADE has decided to suspend the World Congress of the Assemblies of God until further notice.

This certificate is issued so that those affected by the cancellation can prove the circumstances set forth in this document.

## Comunicado sobre la celebración de reuniones multitudinarias durante el periodo de epidemia de COVID-19


Desde que la Organización Mundial de la Salud declarara el pasado mes de enero que la situación relacionada con el COVID-19 constituía una Emergencia de Salud Pública de Interés Internacional, el Ministerio de Sanidad y las comunidades Autónomas realizan un seguimiento constante de la situación con el fin de adoptar las medidas de prevención y contención necesarias y más adecuadas en el marco de nuestro ordenamiento jurídico.

En este sentido, y en consonancia con el oficio firmado por el Ministro de Sanidad el 3 de marzo de 2020 sobre "Recomendaciones de medidas extraordinarias en relación con la situación provocada por el nuevo coronavirus COVID-19", se hacen las siguientes consideraciones:

- Los eventos multitudinarios de cualquier tipo, con alta presencia de personas procedentes de cualquiera de las zonas del mundo en las que se ha constatado transmisión del virus SARS-CoV-2, se consideran evento de riesgo para la transmisión de este patógeno y suponen un riesgo para la salud de la población.
- Se recomienda el aplazamiento de estos eventos (o en su caso la suspensión) hasta que se haya verificado por la autoridad sanitaria el control de la transmisión de la enfermedad y del riesgo asociado.

La Dirección General de Salud Pública, Calidad e Innovación del Ministerio de Sanidad agradece a los organizadores de eventos que se incluyan entre los descritos en este documento la mayor consideración a esta recomendación.

## **Statement on holding multitudinous events during the epidemic period of COVID-19**

Since the World Health Organization declared the situation related to the COVID-19 outbreak as a Public Health International Emergency last January, the Health Ministry and the Autonomous Communities have been constantly monitoring the situation in order to adopt the necessary and most appropriate prevention and containment measures within the framework of our legal system.

In this regard, and in line with the official letter signed by the Ministry of Health on March 3, 2020: "Recommendations of extraordinary measures due to the situation caused by the new coronavirus disease (COVID-19)", the following considerations are made:

- Multitudinous events of any kind, with a high presence of people from any of the areas of the world where SARS-CoV-2 virus transmission has been found, are considered risky events for the transmission of this pathogen as well as posing a risk for the health of the population.
- The postponement of these events (or suspension if necessary) is recommended until the control of the disease transmission and associated risk has been verified by the health authority.

The General Directorate of Public Health, Quality and Innovation of the Ministry of Health thanks their highest consideration to this recommendation to the organizers of the events that are included among those described in this document.
